



The Eddie Cowell Perpetual Trophy is an icon of Australian IOM radio sailing. Past regattas have attracted sailors from across Australia. It offers sailors the opportunity to race in a prestigious multi-fleet event.

The Sunshine Coast Radio Sailing Club's venue at Lake Kawana provides sailors with an elevated view of course from the control area which is on the point of the lake.

Parking will be provided immediately next to the control area. Lake Kawana allows for multiple start lines and course layouts to adjust to changes in the wind direction. August temperatures average from a minimum of 10 C to maximum of 24 C. August winds usually come from the South moving to the North late in the month. Wind speed averages 14 km/hr (7.5 knots).

As an established tourist area the Sunshine Coast has a wide range of accommodation for all tastes and budgets ranging from caravan parks to upmarket resorts within the local area.
